- January 5 - A discussion about *The Occupied Territories – Soldiers’ Live Testimonies 2000-2010* produced by Breaking the Silence.
- January 11 - Screening of *Destiny Hills* and discussion with the director, Lior Kaufman and Mohamad Al-Tlalka from Twayil Abu-Jarwal.
- February 15 - Inauguration of the last two issues of the magazine Sedek. Participants included Safa Aburabia, Dr. Amir Benbeji and Dr. Pnina Mutzafhi-Heller with Mati Shemoelof as the moderator.
